

## Welcome!

Since 2006, High Acres Nature Area (HANA) has been certified through the Wildlife Habitat Council, an international accreditor of programs that create, conserve and restore wildlife habitats on corporate lands. Please enjoy our trail system while protecting our wildlife and habitat.

### We encourage the following activities:

Hiking, Bird and Butterfly Watching, Nature Walks, Fishing (Catch and Release Only) in designated ponds, Cross Country Skiing, and School Field Trips

### For your enjoyment and safe use we prohibit:

Alcoholic Beverages, Drugs, Hunting of any kind, firearms, Paintball, Canoeing/kayaks/boats, Motorized Vehicles, Open Flames/Camp Fires, Overnight Camping, Swimming, Dumping and Littering, Removal of wildlife, plants or trees, Cutting of Trees, Ice Skating, Sledding, Tampering or Defacing of Signage, or building of unauthorized structures. Please respect and obey temporary trail closings as posted.

### Dog walkers

Keep dogs under control or leashed at all times. Dogs are prohibited from water. Dogs and owners should stay on trails. Please clean up after your dog.

### Facility

Open 365 days per year from dawn to dusk. No restrooms or drinking water. Trails may be closed at any time by Waste Management due to nesting birds, flooding, or research being conducted. Signs will be posted to inform users of these activities. Please respect and obey these closings.

## Get Involved!

### Mission statement:

We shall work in the High Acres Nature Area (HANA) complex on the development of natural communities appropriate to the area as an educational and passive recreation resource for the community.

### HANA Volunteer Team:

HANA has a team of dedicated volunteers who are involved in the preservation and management of crucial wetland habitat for a number of amphibian, avian and insect species. Removal of invasive plants and restoration with native plants is a primary focus. Volunteers also work with Waste Management employees to maintain hiking trails. Team member subcommittees work on projects such as:

- Documentation of flora and fauna in variety of habitats
- Data collection and surveying avian breeding and migration using a banding station on site, contributing to the Monitoring Avian Productivity and Survivorship study
- Survey of butterfly populations, food, and nectar plants contributed to the North American Butterfly Association
- Development of a pollinator garden
- Work with Scouts and RIT students on academic and other site projects
- Development of a Conservation Plan
